

The Regulations on President Election

Chapter 1 General Provisions

Article 1 (Purpose) This Regulation is aimed at prescription of matters necessary for the election of the President of Kukkiwon in accordance with paragraph 9 of Article 10 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon (hereinafter referred to as "Election of the President").

Article 2 (Scope of Application) Matters pertaining to the Election of the President shall be subject to this Regulation for matters not prescribed in the Articles of Association. Separate rules may be established as necessary. However, if the Election of the President is entrusted to the National Election Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "National Election Commission") in accordance with the Election Commission Act in accordance with paragraph 7 of Article 10 of the Articles of Association, the Act on Entrusted Election of Public Organizations, etc. and Rules on Entrusted Election of Public Organizations, etc. shall take priority for the Election of the President.

Chapter 2 Setup of Election Commission, etc.

Article 3 (Setup of Election Commission, etc.) ① The Chairman of the Board of Kukkiwon (or person acting for the Chairman. Hereinafter the same) shall form an Election Commission, which is a separate electoral commission that manages the election, by four (4) months before the completion of the term of the President in accordance with paragraph 7 of Article 10 of the Articles of Association. In the case of a by-election, the Election Commission shall be formed within two (2) month of the date that the reason for holding the election was confirmed. However, if special causes such as natural disaster or the influx of infectious diseases occur, 2 months can be elapsed, but shall be composed within 6 months. This also applies in the case of a re-election in accordance with Article 45 or the case in which the Election of the President is entrusted to the National Election Commission in accordance with paragraph 7 of Article 10 of the Articles of Association. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② The Election Commission shall carry out the following affairs:

1. Selection of voters;
2. Preparation for a list of voters;
3. Handling issues pertaining to perusal of lists of voters and objections;
4. Matters pertaining to registration and resignation of candidates and other matters related to pronouncement of candidates;
5. Matters pertaining to suspension, warning, and survey of election campaign management and violations;
6. Matters pertaining to voting, ballot counting, and decision of elected persons;

7. Matters pertaining to the guidance and promotion of the election
8. Other matters not prescribed in the Articles of Association or this Regulation.
- ③ An Election Commission shall be dissolved within 60 days from the date of election. However, the date of dissolution may be deferred based on a decision by the Chairman of the Board under special circumstances. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>
- ④ In this Regulation, the "date that the reason for holding the election was confirmed" refers to the date on which the President could not carry out their duties as a result of death, or resignation or dismissal according to the Articles of Association.

Article 4 (Entrustment of Election Duties) ① In the case that the Election of the President is entrusted to the National Election Commission in accordance with paragraph 7 of Article 10 of the Articles of Association, the application shall be made to the National Election Commission in writing [Attached Form No. 1] by 90 days prior to the completion of the term of the President (in the case of re-elections and by-elections, by fifteen (15) days from the date that the reason for holding the election was confirmed). However, in the case in which this is not possible, the entrustment period may be set differently through consultations with the National Election Commission. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② The scope of the entrustment of the election management according to paragraph 1 is noted in the following subparagraphs.

1. Tasks regarding the registration of candidates (excluding tasks regarding the selection of voters);
2. Tasks regarding votes;
3. Tasks regarding the management of vote counts (including tasks regarding the determination of the electee);
4. Tasks regarding the guidance and promotion of the elections; and,
5. Tasks regarding the regulation and investigation of election campaigns that have violated the law, the Articles of Association, or this Regulation.

③ In the case that the Election of the President is entrusted to the National Election Commission in accordance with paragraph 1, contract shall be made in written form after consulting and coordinating about entrustment affairs, etc. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 5 (Organization of Election Commission) ① An Election Commission shall consist of no less than seven (7) and no more than nine (9) members. External personnel from academia, media, and law backgrounds who are unrelated to the interests of Kukkiwon shall take up the majority. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② The external personnel who are unrelated to the interests of Kukkiwon prescribed in paragraph 1 refer to those who are not executives or employees of Kukkiwon in office (incumbent) in the year the Election Commission is formed, and those who do not hold their positions due to being appointed, elected, or commissioned by the Chairman of the Board or the President, etc. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

③ Members of the Election Commission are appointed by the Chairman of the Board of Kukkiwon with the agreement of the Board of Directors. However, if the Chairman of the Board of Kukkiwon is unable to carry out their duties, either due to an accident or a vacancy, then the acting proxy shall make appointments with the agreement of the Board of Directors in accordance with Article 16 of the Articles of Association.

④ Members of the Election Commission may be recommended by the National Election

Commission and be appointed.

⑤ Directors and employees of Kukkiwon shall not be members of an Election Commission.

⑥ The chair of the Commission shall be elected among members of the Election Commission.

⑦ An Election Commission may appoint a certain number of administrative assistants including one (1) coordinator, and may provide daily expenses, etc. for the work provided.

⑧ Anyone commissioned to be a member of an Election Commission shall not be eligible as a candidate for the relevant Election of the President.

Article 6 (Duties of Members) ① The chair of an Election Commission shall represent the Commission and supervise overall duties.

② Members of an Election Commission shall set up an Election Commission and attend the Election Commission to deliberate and determine matters pertaining to duties.

③ If the chair of an Election Commission cannot carry out their duties, the oldest person among the members shall take over the duties.

Article 7 (Disqualification of Members) ① If anyone is relevant to Article 12 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon, they shall be a member of an Election Commission. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② If a member of an Election Commission pertains to paragraph 1 or is found to be relevant to the Regulation, he/she shall be disqualified.

③ A member of an Election Commission cannot be a voter

Article 8 (Tenure of Member) The tenure of a member of an Election Commission shall begin on the date of appointment and continue to the date of dissolution of the Election Commission.

Article 9 (Convening of Commission, etc) ① A commission may be convened by the chair of an Election Commission as necessary.

② If chair of an Election Commission does not convene a commission without a justifiable reason, a meeting can be convened with an agreement of a majority of registered members.

③ A meeting of an Election Commission shall be opened with a majority of registered members attending and a resolution may be reached with an agreement of a majority of attending members unless otherwise prescribed in the Articles of Association and this Regulation.

④ The chairman of the Election Commission shall have a vote.

Article 10 (Opening of Matters Related to Commission) ① An Election Commission shall not be disclosed to guarantee fairness of deliberation and voting.

② Any member of an Election Commission shall keep personal details, privacy, issues subject to deliberation and other overall matters of President candidates and voters confidential and shall not disclose any information to a third party.

③ Member of the Election Commission shall submit a written oath for the maintenance of secret, etc to Kukkiwon. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

④ An Election Commission shall prepare and conserve minutes containing deliberations of meetings and voted matters.

Article 11 (Expelling, Evasion, etc.) ① The chair and members of an Election Commission shall not engage in deliberation and voting of the Election Commission in the event of the following:

1. A President candidate is a relative (relatives under Article 777 of the Civil Act); and/or,
2. In the event that there is a justifiable reason that compromises fairness.

② If a member of an Election Commission pertains to any paragraph above, they may reveal this in writing and request for avoidance or evade any meeting or deliberation pertaining to the member.

Article 12 (Dismissal of Members) The chairman may dismiss a member of an Election Commission if the member pertains to any of the following. However, in the event that the member pertains to subparagraphs 4 to 6, the relevant member shall be dismissed: <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

1. Corruption related to work;
2. Recognized to be inappropriate as a member of an Election Commission for reasons such as negligence, degradation of dignity, illnesses, etc.;
3. Recognized that carrying out of duties is inappropriate due to a behavior to damage the dignity of members of an Election Commission, such as violation of laws;
4. In the case of not complying with the paragraph 2 of Article 10
5. The person has submitted a resignation at his/her own will; or,
6. The member refrained from avoidance or evasion when relevant to Article 11.

Article 13 (Payment of Conference Fees) Members of an Election Commission may be provided of meeting costs, etc as necessary and within the scope of a relevant budget. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Chapter 3 Organization of Electoral College, etc.

Article 14 (Electoral College) ① Electoral College which is a organization for the president election shall be composed of no less than 70 persons as follows in accordance with paragraph 6 of Article 10 of the Articles of Association. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

1. The president of the World Taekwondo Federation, or one (1) executive designated by the president;
2. The president of the Korea Taekwondo Association, or one (1) executive designated by the president;
3. The chairman of the Taekwondo Promotion Foundation, or one (1) executive designated by the chairman;
4. Two (2) presidents of Taekwondo associations of cities or provinces in Korea that have been recommended by the Korea Taekwondo Association;
5. The presidents of the five (5) Continental Unions, or five (5) executives designated by the presidents;
6. The president of the 9th Dan Association of Kukkiwon, or one (1) executive designated by the president;
7. The president of the Korea Taekwondo Association for the Disabled, or one (1) executive

designated by the president;

8. The president of Korea Women Taekwondo Federation or 1 executive nominated by the chairman; <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

9. Among the national Taekwondo federations in each continent that have contributed greatly to the development of Kukkiwon, 20 persons from Asia, Europe, Pan America, Africa, and Oceania;

10. 40 Taekwondo masters who have contributed to the development of Kukkiwon, composed of 35 Korean masters and five (5) foreign(referring to countries except for Korea) masters; <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

11. One (1) representative for the employees of Kukkiwon; and

12. One (1) Kukkiwon Taekwondo master dispatched overseas.

② Each person relevant to any subparagraph of paragraph 1 shall not overlap with another person presented in the same paragraph.

③ The 'contributed greatly to the development of Kukkiwon' mentioned in subparagraph 9 and 10 of paragraph 1 is an average of the number of candidates recommended for consideration of the Kukkiwon Poom and Dan promotion tests over the three (3) years right before the year when President is elected. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

④ Voters shall be no less than full 19 years old (those who have passed January 1st in the year when they become full 19 years old shall be included first.).

⑤ Voters mentioned in subparagraphs 9 to 12 of paragraph 1 shall be selected by an Election Commission following the contents below based on the materials submitted through cooperation with the office of Kukkiwon. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

1. The number of those mentioned in subparagraph 9 of paragraph 1 shall be a total of 20 including the Presidents of the five (5) Continental Federations covering Asia, Europe, Pan-Am, Africa, and Oceania who have been given the authority to screen and recommend by Kukkiwon, or masters (who have been qualified as masters by Kukkiwon) nominated by the aforementioned Presidents. The number of voters for each of the five (5) Continental Federations shall be allocated as follows: six (6) for Asia, six (6) for Europe, four (4) for Pan-am, two (2) for Africa, and two (2) for Oceania. However, Korea shall be excluded. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

2. Korean masters mentioned in subparagraph 10 of paragraph 1 shall be those authorized to screen and recommend by Kukkiwon and 35 shall be selected based on paragraph 3. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

3. Foreign masters mentioned in subparagraph 10 of paragraph 1 shall be those recommended overseas masters authorized to screen and recommend by Kukkiwon and five (5) shall be selected based on paragraph 3. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

4. National associations mentioned in subparagraph 9 of paragraph 1 and masters mentioned in subparagraph 10 of paragraph 1 shall have valid rights to screen and recommend as presented currently by Kukkiwon. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

5. subparagraph 11 of paragraph 1 is relevant only to regular employees among all employees of Kukkiwon and one shall be selected through voting by all employees. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

6. subparagraph 12 of paragraph 1 refers to those masters dispatched to and remaining active in a foreign country for two (2) years or longer. These masters are dispatched by Kukkiwon. All masters shall select one through drawing. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

⑥ Those pertaining to subparagraph 10 and 12 of paragraph 1 shall have been licensed to

work as masters by Kukkiwon. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

⑦ Following paragraph 5 of Article 10 of the articles of association, The electoral college must be formed by no later than three (3) months before the completion of the term of the president. However, in the case of by-election, the electoral college shall be constituted while considering the schedule after the establishment of Election Commission of paragraph 3. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 15 (Request to Recommend Voters) ① An Election Commission shall request related associations to recommend voters within 14 days with an aim to organize electoral college in accordance with subparagraph 1 through 8 of paragraph 1 of Article 14. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② An Election Commission shall request related divisions of Kukkiwon to send out materials in order to organize electoral college in accordance with subparagraph 9 through 12 of paragraph 1 of Article 14. Materials related to subparagraph 9 to 10 of paragraph 1 of Article 14 must be requested up to threefolds to confirm the acceptance from the top rank. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

③ An Election Commission shall make a request as described in paragraph 1 as a national association is selected through the materials pertaining to paragraph 2 as for subparagraph 9 of paragraph 1 of Article 14. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 16 (Preparation of List for Voters) ① The Election Commission shall check for eligibility based on Article 14 and overlaps based on the list submitted by voters in accordance with Article 15. It shall then prepare a list for voters[Attached Form No. 2] over the course of three (3) days starting from 17 days before the election date.

② An Election Commission, if someone has been recommended repetitively as a voter, shall observe each of the following:

1. If there is any overlap of persons recommended by a group over subparagraph 1 through 9 of paragraph 1 of Article 14, it shall be decided where the person has been recommended based on the intent of the person and the group which has recommended same persons shall be asked to change the persons recommended. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

2. If there is any overlap between persons recommended by a group based on subparagraph 1 through 9 of paragraph 1 of Article 14 and persons originating from subparagraphs 10 and 12 of paragraph 1 of Article 14, the group's recommendation shall be prioritized, and persons following the next order shall be selected for subparagraphs 10 and 12. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

③ As for subparagraph 10 through 12 of paragraph 1 of Article 14, an Election Commission shall select after checking acceptance as a voter. If not accepted, it may be transferred to the next in rank by the decision of the Election Commission until the day before the List for Voters browsing day. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

④ Voters shall submit an Agreement to Collection and Use of Personal Data and Provision to Third Parties [Attached Form No. 3] and if anyone selected is not qualified, there shall be an immediate request for another recommendation.

⑤ Persons finally listed in the list of the electoral college shall not be replaced with other persons.

- Article 17 (Perusal of List of Voters, Etc.)** ① Once a list of voters is prepared in accordance with Article 16, the Election Commission shall set a location and allow voters to see the list.
- ② The perusal period for the list of voters shall be set as three (3) days, and shall be between the day after the expiration date for the list's preparation and the day before the finalization of the list.
- ③ The list of voters shall be finalized 11 days before the election date.
- ④ Any voters may object to an Election Commission orally or in writing if it is recognized that there is any omission or error in the list or anyone is not qualified.
- ⑤ An Election Commission, if there is any objection based on paragraph 4, shall screen and decide by the date following the date of objection. When it is decided that the request is reasonable, the list of voters shall be immediately revised, which must then be notified to relevant groups, applicants and related people pertaining to subparagraph 1 through 12 of paragraph 1 of Article 14. If it is decided that there is no reason, it shall be notified to the applicant. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>
- ⑥ During the candidate registration and application period, candidates may apply to receive a copy of the list of voters, and upon receiving the application, the Election Commission shall issue a copy of the list by the commencement day of the election period.

Chapter 4 Qualification and Registration of Candidates

- Article 18 (Qualification of Candidates)** ① A candidate shall be a holder of a Kukkiwon Taekwondo 6th or higher Dan based in paragraph 1 of Article 10 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>
- ② Anyone disqualified based on Article 12 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon shall not be a candidate. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>
- ③ In case of the registration as a candidate by the executive and employee of Kukkiwon, World Taekwondo, Korea Taekwondo Association, Taekwondo Promotion Foundation, Kukkiwon Taekwondo 9th Dan Holder Federation, Korea Taekwondo Association for the Disabled, Korea Women Taekwondo Federation and any other affiliated organizations that can directly influence the Election of the President, such as the formation of electoral college, he/she shall resign (step down) from their positions in the aforementioned organizations by no later than three (3) months before the completion of the term of the President. However, in the case that the executives or employees are registered as candidates for the President in a re-election or by-election, they shall resign (step down) within ten (10) days of the date that the reason for holding the election was confirmed. However, when the formation of electoral college has been deferred due to a special circumstances such as natural disaster or the influx of infectious diseases, they shall resign (step down) within ten (10) days of the date An Election Commission determined. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>
- Article 19 (Donation)** ① Anyone who applies for registration shall donate 30 million KRW to the Election Commission (National Election Commission) right upon his/her application.
- ② Payment of donations shall be in KRW. Payments shall be made into an account opened with the financial institution (including the post office) by the Election Commission (National Election Commission) for the purpose of receiving donation deposits, and the payment shall

be in the name of the person applying to be registered as a candidate. Donations shall be made with credit slips issued by the financial institution concerned. However, in the case in which this is impossible, payment may be made in cash (including cashier's checks issued by the financial institution).

③ If the Election Commission (National Election Commission) has received a donation in cash based on paragraph 2, a receipt shall be issued and the money shall be put into the financial institution.

Article 20 (Announcement of Contest of Candidates) ① The Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall announce the details on the registration of candidates including the period on the website of the Kukkiwon or through other means for no less than 14 days between 25 days before the election date and the day before the candidate registration commencement date.

② The Election Commission (National Election Commission), when announcing based on paragraph 1, shall display the reasons for disqualification of executives decided in accordance with the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon.

Article 21 (Registration of Candidate, etc.) ① Anyone who wishes to be a candidate shall apply to the Election Commission (National Election Commission) for registration, which also may be conducted by an agent with a letter of attorney, over two days from two days before the date to start election campaign (date following the final candidate registration date) in writing. In this case, the receipt of the application forms shall take place between 9 am and 6 pm every day regardless of public holidays in local time of Kukkiwon.

② Persons applying to be registered as candidates shall submit the following documents, and, if the documents are in a foreign language, shall attach Korean translations to the documents.

1. An application form to register as a candidate to become President [Attached Form No. 4];
2. Family Relation Certificate;
3. Certificate of absence of registration of under-age guardians or quasi-incompetent people;
4. Document pertaining to previous punishment (only to relevant people) of a candidate after issuance of the form [Attached Form No. 5] coming from a Taekwondo or sports group where the candidate previously belonged;
5. Written oath confirming that there is no disqualification of an executive [Attached Form No. 6];
6. A list of signatures of more than 50 and less than 70 who are fourth graders or above as qualified by Kukkiwon [Attached Form No. 7];
7. Documents certifying a donation or payment of a donation according to Article 19;
8. Certificate of Resignation (Step-down) (limited to those who used to be executives based on paragraph 3 of Article 18); and,
9. An Agreement to Collection and Use of Personal Data and Provision to Third Parties [Attached Form No. 8];
10. Other documents designated by the Election Commission as necessary for management

③ Holders of Kukkiwon 4th Dan and higher of subparagraph 6 of paragraph 2 may recommend multiple candidates for President.

④ In the case of candidates with nationalities other than Korean, documents issued by their corresponding nation's governments may be used in lieu of the documents listed in subparagraph 2, subparagraph 3 and subparagraph 10 of paragraph 2.

⑤ The Election Commission (National Election Commission), once it receives a candidate registration application, shall accept it immediately. However, applications for registration which are not equipped with documents presented under paragraphs 1 through 10 of Article 2 shall not be accepted.

⑥ The Election Commission (National Election Commission) may request for related institutions to check matters related to qualification including checking of the criminal record of a candidate after registration of the candidate. It may also request related institutions to check the qualification for registration and the candidate shall pro-actively respond to such activities.

⑦ The Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall invalidate registration of a candidate if there is a reason pertaining to the following after registration of a candidate:

1. It has been found that the candidate is not qualified for being voted; and/or,
2. The documents mentioned in paragraphs 1 through 8 of Article 2 have not been submitted or are untrue.

⑧ When the Election Commission (National Election Commission) has invalidated a candidate's registration, it shall be notified to the candidate alongside the reason of disqualification.

⑨ Numbers of candidates used for ordering of listing candidates shall be decided through drawing of agents as well as candidates on the final date of registration. However, if there is any absence, the Election Commission (National Election Commission) may draw the number of the candidate.

⑩ The documents mentioned in paragraph 2 received by the Election Commission (National Election Commission) from candidates will not be returned.

Article 22 (Reporting of Resignation of Candidates) ① If a candidate wishes to resign, the candidate or their agent with a letter of attorney shall visit the Election Commission (National Election Commission) or the relevant division of Kukkiwon that supports management of the Election Commission and report the resignation in writing.

② The Election Commission (National Election Commission), if a candidate has registered, resigned, passed away, or been disqualified, shall announce the fact on the website of Kukkiwon immediately.

Chapter 5 Election and Campaign

Article 23 (Election Period and Election Date) ① The "election period" refers to the period from the day after the closing of candidate registration to the election date, and shall be ten (10) days.

② The Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall hold the president election followed by paragraph 5 of Article 10 of the Articles of association, and the date of election, etc shall be prescribed by 25 days before the date, and shall be notified on website of Kukkiwon, etc. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 24 (Definition of Election Campaign) An election campaign refers to actions carried out to ensure that oneself or another specific individual is elected, or to ensure that oneself or another specific person is not elected. However, any of the following shall not be regarded as election campaign:

1. Representation of opinions and intents on an election;
2. Preparation for candidacy and election campaign; and/or,
3. Overall business affairs

Article 25 (Main Body and Method of Election Campaign) ① Candidates shall only engage in election campaigns in any one (1) of the methods listed in the following subparagraphs, and no one other than the candidates themselves shall engage in election campaigns.

1. Direct conversation between caller and receiver through telephone calls;
2. Text messaging (including audio, videos, etc. other than texts);
3. Electronic mail (referring to the communication system in which computer users exchange information such as texts, audio, and videos through a network);
4. Distribution of business cards (within 9cm in length and 5cm in width); and,
5. Introduction of candidates and presentation of opinions on the election date.

② The election campaign methods in accordance with the presentation of opinions in subparagraph 5 of paragraph 1 are as follows:

1. The chair of the Election Commission shall introduce each candidate to the voters according to the sequential order of their numbers at the voting booth or the site of the Board of Directors either on the election date or run-off election date before the voting begins, and shall have the candidates present their opinions. In this case, each candidate shall be given the same amount of time for their presentations, and the time shall be in the range of 10 minutes.
2. Any candidates who have failed to reach the voting booth by the time their turn to present their opinions has come shall be considered to have given up their chance to present their opinions.
3. The chair of the Election Commission shall intervene and stop candidates who deliver an address or remark that violates this Regulation, and shall carry out necessary measures, such as suspending the presentation of opinions, in cases where the candidates refuse to follow their orders.
4. The chair of the Election Commission shall intervene and stop persons who prevent candidates from presenting their opinions or cause disorder, and may order such persons to leave the voting booth if they refuse to comply with demands to stop.
5. Nobody shall keep or otherwise carry signs with a candidate's symbol, photograph, name, etc. during the presentation of opinions.

③ Candidates may not engage in election campaigns with details regarding their academic records, careers, etc. that are not true.

④ Detailed election campaign methods for each subparagraph of paragraph 1 shall follow the stipulations of the Election Commission (National Election Commission)

Article 26 (Duration of Election Campaign) ① Election campaign shall be limited to a period

starting from the date following the last registration date to the date prior to the election date. However, there shall be exceptions if a candidate presents their opinion on the date of election.

Article 27 (Restrictions in Election Campaigns) ① No one shall engage in any of the following with a purpose to elect or fail himself/herself or other specific person;

1. Any activity of providing money, goods, regalement, profit in property, or public and private positions to voters (prior to the creation of the list of voters, this includes persons who have the qualification to be put on the list of voters), families of voters (this refers to the spouses of the voters, direct ancestors, descendants and siblings of the voters and their spouses, and spouses of direct ancestors, descendants and siblings of the voters: hereinafter the same shall apply), or institutions, groups, and facilities founded/operated by a voter or their families, and any activity of expressing the intent or promising to provide such;
2. Any activity pertaining to subparagraph 1 regarding candidates and persons seeking to be candidates for the purpose of preventing another from becoming a candidate or forcing a candidate to resign;
3. Any activity of being provided or accepting the intent to be provided with profits or positions as prescribed in paragraphs 1 or 2; and,
4. Any persons who have directed, suggested, brokered, or requested the activities prescribed in paragraphs 1 through 3.

② Anyone shall not visit each voters or mobilize others to gather in a specific place for election campaign.

③ No one shall slander candidates by announcing false facts or making public statements regarding the Election of the President through telephone, text, business cards, electronic mail, websites on the internet, or through other methods.

④ A candidate shall not have an election office or election officials.

Article 28 (Punishment) ① The Election Commission may punish those who have engaged in and been revealed to have been involved in the behaviors prohibited in the Articles of Association and this Regulation based on the decisions made by the Election Commission:

1. If a violation is recognized to seriously damage fairness of an election or the relevant party fails to implement suspension, warning or corrective actions;
 - A. Invalidation of registration or election winning (limited to candidates only);
 - B. Deprivation of rights to elect held by a voter;
 - C. Request made to Reward and Punishment Committee of Kukkiwon or a group to which
 - D. Restriction on future application for all other events related to Kukkiwon, businesses, screening and qualification as well as restriction on employment and activities as executives and employees of Taekwondo organizations in addition to restriction on participation (limited to those who don't belong to Taekwondo organizations);
 - E. Suspension from various qualifications acquired from Kukkiwon, such as Poom and Dan Certificates and master, referee, and judge qualifications, expulsions, and restrictions on issuance of various certificates;
 - F. Request for investigation to relevant investigative institution or a lawsuit; and/or,
 - G. Punishment prescribed in clauses of the same subparagraph above may take place

simultaneously.

2. When it is recognized that violations damage the fairness of election to a lower extent;
 - A. Request for suspension through oral and written means or warning and corrective orders (limited to the first-time violation);
 - B. Notification of violations and punishment to Voters;
 - C. Display of violations and punishments in each voting place on the date of election; and/or,
 - D. Punishment pertaining to each activity under the same subparagraph as well as same numbers can take place simultaneously.

② In the case that the written oath (Written Oath Confirming Absence of Disqualifying Matters of Executives) on subparagraph 5 of paragraph 2 of Article 21 is found to be false, the violating party will be permanently expelled, and the electee's victory will naturally be canceled.

Article 29 (Organization of the Fair Election Support Group) ① The Election Commission (National Election Commission) may establish the Fair Election Support Group to watch over an election, consisting of neutral and fair people for prevention, monitoring and suspension of violations of the Election of the President.

② The maximum number of members to monitor corruption in an election mentioned in paragraph 1 shall be limited to six (6) and they can be compensated with allowances or actual expenses.

Article 30 (Duty to Remain Neutral for Executives and Employees of Kukkiwon the World Taekwondo Headquarters, etc.) ① Executives and employees of Kukkiwon shall not engage in unfair influences in the election or act to affect other results of an election.

② The Election Commission (National Election Commission), if executives and employees of Kukkiwon leak information without approval of the Election Commission (National Election Commission) in relation to organization of electoral college or engage in other violations, may request the Reward and Punishment Committee (Disciplinary Committee) of Kukkiwon to impose punishment. Otherwise, it can file a lawsuit. However, this is relevant only when there is sufficient proof. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 31 (Method of Election, etc.) ① The election shall be based on secret voting.

② For voting, voters shall make a sign on the ballot(including online voting). <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

③ As for voting, one voter may exercise one vote.

④ When electing, there shall not be any display enabling assumption of name and other personal details of a voter.

⑤ The Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall check a voter based on the identity identifiers (resident registration certificate, passport, driver's license and/or public official certificate etc.) first and then, offer a ballot.

Article 32 (Place of Voting) The Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall set up places of voting by the date prior to the election date.

Article 33 (Ballot) ① A ballot shall carry signals and names of candidates. The signals shall appear as "1, 2 and 3" in accordance with the order of placement of candidates. Names shall be given both in Korean and English. If there are candidates of same name, the date of birth shall be presented within the parenthesis.

② If there is only one candidate, despite paragraph 1, the name of the candidate shall appear on the ballot and voters shall be able to approve or dismiss the candidate.

Article 34 (Voting Time) ① Voting time shall be prescribed by the Election Commission (National Election Commission).

② Voters are waiting in line at the polling station (limited to one in the Republic of Korea) to vote when the voting is near end shall be provided with numbers so that they can vote before closing. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 35 (Dispatch of Voting Guidelines) ① The Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall dispatch voting guidelines to voters no later than two (2) days after the list of voters is finalized, and the voting guidelines shall contain details such as the name of the voters, registration number for the list of voters, location of the voting booth, voting hours, necessary items for voting, voting procedure, and message recommending voters to participate in the vote.

② In the case of the voters with nationalities other than Korean, the Election Commission (National Election Commission) may transmit using the mode of electronic mail, and produce voting guidelines in English.

Article 36 (Online Voting) ① Notwithstanding Article 10 of the articles of association and this prescription, voting by internet based personal computer and mobile communication terminal (smart phone, tablet computer, etc) (hereinafter "online voting") is allowed, and the detailed procedures or methods of online voting shall be specified in a separate rule which is to obtain approval from the Board of Directors. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② When enabling an elector to exercise voting franchise through online voting according to the paragraph 1, the fact about holding online voting and voting period, etc shall be informed in advance. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

③ In accordance with the decision of Election Commission (National Election Commission), other voting method may be run in parallel with online voting. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 37 (Participation in Voting and Ballot Counting) ① A candidate shall select up to two (2) voting participants in each voting place by two days prior to the election date. They shall select no more than two (2) people obliged to check ballot counting and report them to the Election Commission (National Election Commission) in writing by the date prior to the election date. In this case, the persons taking part in the ballot counting may be those who oversee the voting.

② If a candidate has failed to report as the voting observers and vote tally observers in accordance with paragraph 1, it shall be regarded as them having given up on observing the voting and vote tallying.

③ When there is no selection of an observer or there is only those observers selected by one candidate, the Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall secure up to four (4) selected people to observe the voting based on approval of people who are fair and neutral. In

this case, any person selected to be an observer shall submit their letter of approval.

④ Candidates, spouses of candidates or executives and employees of Kukkiwon shall not be voting or ballot observers.

Article 38 (Objection to Effects of Voting) ① Candidates or electors intending to object to the election or the effectiveness of the selection must file an objection in written form to the Election Commission within 2 days from the day after the election. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② When a ballot-counting observer finds an illegal matter related to the counting, he or she may request for correction immediately. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 39 (Donations) ① The Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall return donations in full within 30 days of the election date to candidates who have won no less than 20/100 of the total number of valid votes or have passed away. Donations from candidates who have won less than 20/100 of the total number of valid votes shall be vested in Kukkiwon in full. In this case, the return of donations shall depend on the results of the 1st vote.

② Donations from candidates whose registrations have been nulled or who have resigned shall not be returned, and shall be vested in Kukkiwon.

Article 40 (Validity of Election etc.) ① The election shall be valid with voting (including valid, invalid votes and abstentions) of the majority of the electoral college. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② Deleted <2020. 12. 09.>

Article 41 (Payment for Daily Labor, etc.) Kukkiwon may provide expenses for daily labor and meal prices to voters, voting observers, and vote tally observers. However, agreement from all candidates shall be received before paying out expenses for daily labor to voters.

Chapter 6 Decision of Election

Article 42 (Decision of Elected Persons) ① The candidates who have received majority of valid votes in the valid election in accordance with paragraph 1 of Article 40 shall be decided as the elected persons. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

② If there is no winner with the most votes provided for in paragraph 1, the candidates who won the 1st and 2nd place shall be subject to re-election so that a winner with the most votes can become an electee.<Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

③ If those who won the 1st place is more than 2 people in the election provided for in paragraph 1, revoting shall be taken on all of those who won the 1st place. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

④ If there is a winner with the most votes and more than 2 people in second place in the election provided for in paragraph 1, revoting shall be taken on the winner and the second place winners. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

⑤ If the majority votes are the same number in the election provided for in paragraph 2, the elected shall be one who has higher Taekwondo Dan. If the Dan is same, the elected

shall be one who passed the final Taekwondo Dan test earlier. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

⑥ Even in the cases of having only one (1) candidate after the registration is completed, or due to reasons such as the death or invalid registration of the other registered candidates, the election shall be valid with voting (including valid, invalid votes and abstentions) of the majority of the electoral college. and the candidate is elected if having received the majority of valid votes. <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>

Article 43 (Invalidation of Election) If the elected President is found to have reasons pertaining to disqualification under the Articles of Association, the effect of election will be lost.

Article 44 (Notification of Elected President, etc.) The Election Commission, once President is elected, shall announce the winner on the website of Kukkiwon on the date following the election date in accordance with [Attached Form No. 9].

Chapter 7 Subsidiary Provisions

Article 45 (Re-election) ① If any of the following is relevant, a re-election shall take place:

1. There is no candidate;
2. The Election Commission (National Election Commission) has decided to annul the election;
3. A majority of the electoral college did not vote; <Amended on Dec 09, 2020>
4. The electee has resigned or passed away before the commencement of their term.

② In the case of annulment of the election in accordance with subparagraph 2 of paragraph 1, the Election Commission (National Election Commission) shall return the donations donated by the candidates. However, if the reasons for the decision of annulment of the election are directly due to a certain candidate, the donations of the candidate concerned shall not be returned.

③ If the Election Commission (National Election Commission) chooses to conduct a re-election in accordance with subparagraph 3 of paragraph 1 despite paragraph 1 of Article 3, then the procedure before the election date shall be considered valid, and a separate election date shall be decided and a vote and vote tally shall be held.

Article 46 (By-elections) A by-election shall be conducted in the case that the position of President is vacant.

Article 47 (Measures to Violations) The Election Commission (National Election Commission) may take necessary measures such as suspension, warning, corrective actions and surveys based on Articles 72 and 73 of the 「Act on Elections Entrusted by Public Organizations, etc.」

Article 48 (Protection of Reporters of Election Crimes) No one shall inform others, disclose, or report the personal details of reporters of violations or any facts that may lead them to know that one is a reporter.

Article 49 (Other Matters) Any matters regarding the Election of the President that has not been stipulated by the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon or this Regulation shall be determined by the decision of the Election Commission. However, if the Election of the President has been entrusted to the National Election Commission, the decision will be made through consultations.

Article 50 (Interpretation of Languages) If there is a discrepancy or difference in interpretation between the Korean version and English version of this Regulation and the various documents related to this Regulation, then the Korean version shall prevail.

Article 51 (Revision of Regulation) Revision of this Regulation is subject to approval of the Board of Directors.

Addenda (July 19, 2019)

Article 1 (Date of Enforcement) This Regulation shall take effect on the date of resolution by the Board of Directors.

Article 2 (Interim Measures) ① For the first Election of the President held in accordance with this Regulation, matters such as the formation period of the Election Commission, election schedule, and basic dates for various decisions may be set separately according to the decision of the Board of Directors despite this Regulation, and the application period for resignation (stepping down) in the paragraph 3 of Article 18 shall be within ten (10) days of the day after the appointment day for members of the Election Commission.

② The date on which the reason for holding the first Election of the President is finalized shall be the appointment day for members of the Election Commission in accordance with the paragraph 3 of Article 5 of this Regulation.

③ The candidate elected as President in accordance with the first Election of the President shall have their term begin anew, and the term shall begin from the date on which the President electee is publically announced.

Article 3 (Restriction on Additional Positions) Any member of the Election Commission organized hereunder shall not work as members of the Director Recommendation Committee, which is being operated at the same time.

Addenda (December 09, 2020)

Article 1 (Date of Enforcement) This prescription shall take effect on the date the Articles of Association resolved by the Board of Directors obtain approval from the Minister of Culture, Sports and Tourism.

Article 2 (Interim Measures of the Fixed Date of Grounds for Holding) The Date of Implementation in Article 1 of the Addenda applies to the president election when grounds for holding occur on Aug 18, 2020.
